Hazard	Potential casualties	Risk evaluation	Control measures	Review/Notes April 2020
Being hit by a ball or other object	anyone, including outside the hall	D 2 specs may be knocked off. ball may impact with face, etc.	use indoor balls only in hall  Keep door closed as much as possible	<b>before a game starts, ensure everyone has understood the rules</b>
slipping over L2	anyone	D2	advise players to wear suitable footwear;	clean up any spills, especially candle wax or oil check shoe laces
collisions between people L2	anyone	D2	stop game and assess any injury	
colliding with wall or floor L2	anyone	D1 especially, banging head	referee/organiser must exercise vigilance; players must be warned and reminded of danger	all head injuries to be noted in first aid book and reported to parents
colliding with furniture/ obstructions L2	anyone	D1	remove all obstructions before game starts	

**Likelihood:**

1. certain
2. very likely
3. possible
4. unlikely
5. very unlikely.

**Danger level:**

1. risk of severe injury
2. risk of moderate injury
3. risk of slight injury
